AGREEMENT TERMS

- 1) The consignor hereby consigns for sale the following work(s) to the Sheldon Rose Gallery:

- 2) The consignor shall receive **50 %** of the selling price realized by the consignee, in the event that the consigned artwork is sold by the consignee.
- 3) The consignee agrees to inform the consignor of any completed sales of the consigned artwork within 30 days of such sales, and to provide the consignor with the name of the purchaser. A sale shall only be deemed to have been completed upon the receipt of full payment of the purchase price.
- 4) The consignee will be responsible for the safekeeping of the artwork while in its possession but will neither insure nor guarantee the artwork against theft or damage.
- 5) The consignor retains copyright and all reproduction rights to the consigned artwork but the consignee may make images of the work for the purposes of promotion and sale crediting the artist as appropriate. This includes websites and other on-line postings.
- 6) The consignee does not guarantee the exhibition or sale of consigned artwork.
- 7) Either the consignor or the consignee may cancel this agreement with written notice. In the event that this agreement is cancelled, the consignor is responsible for the removal of any unsold consignments within seven days of cancellation.
- 8) The consignor appoints the consignee as an authorized agent for the consigned as part of this agreement. The consignor warrants that they own the artwork herein listed and all proprietary rights to it without encumbrance and that they have the right to appoint the consignee as an agent to sell it. The consignor retains title in each work consigned until fully paid for any sale at which time title passes directly to whomever bought the work except as noted below.
- 9) **CONSIGNMENTS NOT SOLD DURING SHOW:** The consignor agrees to,
___ i) Pick up unsold consignments from the Gallery within 30 calendar days of show closing, or
___ ii) Pay for the return of the consignment to the consignor within 21 calendar days of the show closing, or
The consignor agrees that disposition of any consignment not removed from the Gallery within 30 days of the show closing shall be at the discretion of the consignee.

This agreement is governed by the laws of the Province of Ontario and the Dominion of Canada.
